Growing in God's Grace and Knowledge

The story of Aquila and Priscilla helps us understand some of the ways God helps us to grow in our Christian walk.

It seems Aquila and Priscilla were already Christians when they met Paul in Corinth, and it also seems they took to it well.

Not only did they share the same trade of tentmaking (or leatherworking), they shared a love of the truth.

They followed Paul as far as Ephesus, and after he left, a Bible scholar named Apollos came to town.

"He had been taught the way of the Lord and talked to others with great enthusiasm and accuracy about Jesus. However, he knew only about John's baptism. When Priscilla and Aquila heard him preaching boldly in the synagogue, they took him aside and explained the way of God more accurately" (Acts 18: 25-26, New Living Translation).

This caring couple were not trying to show off their knowledge, but to truly help and encourage another believer to grow. Their own faithful study had prepared them to humbly teach and help others.

What was the result? "By the words of Aquila and Priscilla he was more fully instructed

When Apollos traveled on to Greece, he "proved to be of great benefit to those who, by God's grace, had believed. He faced all the Jews with powerful arguments in public debate. Using the Scriptures, he explained to them, 'The Messiah you are looking for is Jesus'" (Acts 18:27-28).

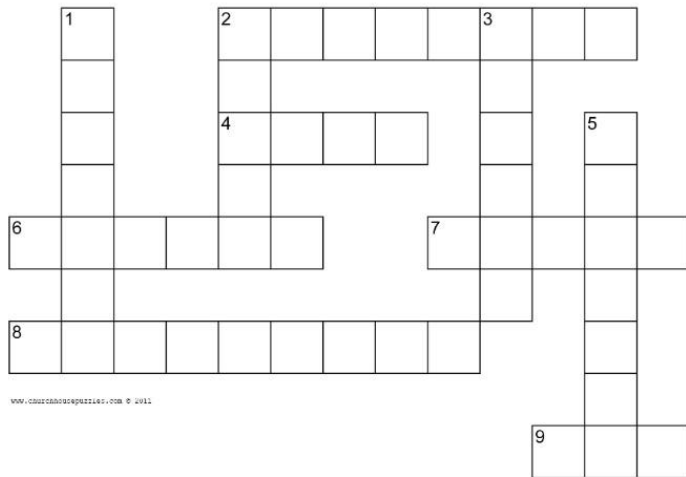

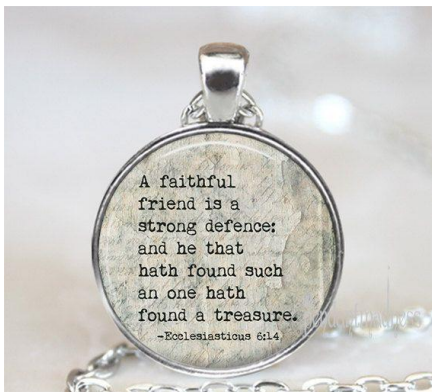
